

Simple Large Poppy Knitting Pattern for Netting



Pattern:

Cast on 100 stitches (I used Size 6 (5mm) needles)
Knit 20 rows in red

Decrease as follows - slip one, knit 2together, pass slip stitch over. Repeat to end, knit 1. (34 stitches)
Next row, knit 2together to end (17 stitches)

Cast on black wool and knit 4 rows. Pass wool through stitches and draw up to circle.

Sew together leaving a long tail of black in the centre and tail of red at the edge to facilitate sewing on.

N.B. different size needles will result in different size poppies (not a problem).

Feel free to adapt pattern to vary size, colour etc according to what you have available. (Bigger needles, bigger poppy!)

Please only use garter stitch (Knit only) so the poppy lies flat on the netting,
