Simple Small Poppy Knitting Pattern for Netting



Small amounts of RED, BLACK and GREEN Double-Knit wool Size 3.5 or 3.75 needles (UK 9)

Poppy

- Cast on 60 stitches.
- Work 8-10 rows garter stitch (All rows knitted).
- Reduce 60 stitches to 20 slip 1, knit 2 tog, pass slip stich over to end.
- Reduce 20 stitches to 10 by knitting 2 together to end.

<u>Centre</u>

- Continue to knit two rows in black before slipping wool through stitches and gently pull into circle.
- Sew poppy along seams and leave some wool 'tails' for sewing onto netting.

Leaf (Optional)

- Cast on 3 stitches in green wool.
- Knit to the front and back of the same stitch (kfb), knit 1, kfb (5 stitches).
- K1, p3, k1 (5)
- Kfb, k3, kfb (7)
- K1, p5 k1 (7)
- Kfb, k5, kfb (9)
- K1, p7, k1(9)
- Kfb, k7, kfb (11)
- K1, p9, k1 (11)
- K11
- P11
- P2tog, k7, p2tog (9)
- K1, p7, k1 (9)
- P2tog,k5, k1 (7)
- K1, p5, k1 (7)
- P2tog, k3, p2tog (5)
- K1, p3, k1 (5)
- P2tog, k1, p2tog (3) Cast off purl-wise.
- Sew green leaf to back of poppy so it shows from behind.#

THIS PATTERN CAN BE ADAPTED AS YOU WISH – BIGGER NEEDLES, MORE STITCHES, THICKER WOOL. LOTS OF VARIATION IS GOOD BUT THEY NEED TO BE JUST GARTER STITCH TO LAY FLAT.
